

## Master's Greenwich Visit

Saturday 18 June 2022



This is a one-day visit for a maximum of 50 to three venues in the London Borough of Greenwich:

- The military centre at Woolwich
- The Greenwich Design District
- Royal Greenwich

The day will begin at Tower Millennium Pier to catch the Thames Clipper to Woolwich where we'll be met by a coach for the rest of the day's transportation. We shall leave the coach in Blackheath for evening drinks and buffet supper with the Master and Mistress, professionally catered by Klose and Soane.

Visitors can connect with public transport home from nearby Blackheath or Lewisham Stations.



Depart from Central London at 9:29 from Tower Millennium Pier using Thames Clipper route RB1 eastbound



We shall be provided with headsets for the whole day and during the trip a real-time description of the passing riverside architecture will be given.



Upon arriving Woolwich Arsenal Pier at 10:14 walk through redeveloped Royal Arsenal to meet our coach and guide for the day.



Our first visit is to St Georges Garrison Church where we will be met by Tim Barnes Chairman of the Friends Group who will introduce us to the project.



Walk across to James Wyatt's 1802 Royal Artillery Barracks to be met by the Officers by kind arrangement with Lt Colonel Ed Taylor and taken for a guided tour of the Mess.



Re-join the coach to take us via Wyatt's Military Academy and Inigo Jones' Charlton House to North Greenwich





Visit Greenwich Design District where the 9 different architects practices prioritised natural ventilation, high ceilings, north-facing lights and pedestrian movement for a healthy and happy workplace.



Then on to the 1801 Fullers "The Pilot" for lunch (not included in the day's cost) as you wish. After lunch re-join the coach to take us from Greenwich Peninsular to Royal Greenwich.



We leave the coach for an afternoon visit by foot to the many architectural gems of Royal Greenwich. Firstly, taking in Wren's recently restored Greenwich Hospital Painted Hall
