



### British Association of Clinical Anatomists Winter Meeting 2022 - Information for delegates

We are delighted to welcome you to the Human Anatomy Resource Centre at the University of Liverpool. Below is some information for your visit.

#### Location

The meeting will be held in the Human Anatomy Resource Centre (HARC), 3<sup>rd</sup> floor Sherrington Building, Ashton Street, University of Liverpool. L69 3GE. Please see the blue dot on the map below for the location of the entrance.

## **Getting to the HARC**

Road

From the M62: at the end of the motorway continue straight ahead onto Edge Lane (A5080 then A5047) and follow signs for Liverpool City Centre and the University.

Postcode for sat nav or online directions: L3 5TR

Rail

The Campus is a ten minute walk from the nearest mainline station at Lime Street.

Take the main exit and turn left into Lime Street. Then turn left again at the Britannia Adelphi Hotel and continue up Brownlow Hill towards the Metropolitan Catholic Cathedral and Red Brick Building with its clock tower.

Coach

The National Express coach station is in Liverpool One Bus Station, Canning Place, Liverpool, L1 8JX, an 18 minute walk from the Campus. From the bus station walk along Hanover Street, pass Liverpool Central Train Station. Cross Renshaw street onto Brownlow Hill and head towards the Metropolitan Catholic Cathedral.

Air

Liverpool Airport

Liverpool John Lennon Airport is eight miles from the city and is best reached by taxi or the express bus, directly outside the entrance to the airport terminal. You can also get buses 500, 86, 80A and 82A to Liverpool city centre.

#### Manchester Airport

A train service runs between Manchester Airport and Liverpool Lime Street station. There is also a direct coach service which takes about 1 hour.

### **Car Parking**

The visitor car parks are located at Brownlow Street and Mount Pleasant (opposite the Catholic Cathedral).

Please see the map below for visitor car park locations. They are marked as green dots.

The visitor car parks are pay on exit car parks and you receive a ticket at the barrier upon entrance to the car park, then when you are preparing to leave the car park you pay at the pay station.

Pay stations accept various methods of payment including card, note and coin readers; however, we do advise that you have the correct money to avoid any delays.

The charge tariff for your visit will be as follows:

Peak (Weekdays from 7.30am until 5.30pm)

Up to 1 hour - £2.00

Up to 2 hours - £3.00

Up to 3 hours - £4.00

Up to 4 hours - £5.00

Over 4 hours - £6.00

#### **HARC Rules and Regulations**

As the HARC is a licensed facility we **do not** allow any mobile phones on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor. For the times you are in HARC you will be asked to put your mobile phone in a locker for safe keeping. If you need to use your phone, you are able to outside of the department. If you are expecting an important phone call, please let us know. We can look after your phone and alert you to an incoming call.

As with everyone attending the HARC we also ask that you dress in an appropriate manner for an anatomy department.

### Wi-Fi access
