

Conclusion:

- Five years since the NCEPOD ^[2] recommendations (growth monitoring for all disabled children, and appropriate resources for healthcare facilities), this audit shows recording growth for CYP at each clinical encounter is still not universal, and there remain healthcare resource challenges (time, staff training, equipment and appropriate charts.)
- The BACD WEIGH TO GO! initiative aims to reduce inequality in growth monitoring for all CYP; through professional peer support, web resources, and regular audit.
