The vestibular system in children is an important system significantly involved in the development of balance, muscle tone, posture, spatial and cognitive orientation and indeed overall development.

After the hugely successful previous 6 courses that saw attendances from 10 different countries from around the world, we are delighted to announce the unique 7th Alder Hey Paediatric Vestibular Course exploring the different aspects of the paediatric vestibular system including anatomy, physiology and development of the vestibular system in children and diagnosis, aetiology and management of paediatric vestibular disorders. Added topics that are latest cutting edges in the field will feature vestibular infant screening and virtual reality for treating paediatric vestibular disorders. The course is aimed at clinicians in any discipline involved with paediatric balance. The course is open to a national and an international audience and will be held over 2 full days.

The course is enriched by an international faculty from Maastricht University, the University of Siena and the University of Alabama at Birmingham and also by national experts who practice paediatric vestibular medicine. There will be interactive case-based discussions and practical workshops on the diagnosis and rehabilitation of paediatric vestibular disorders.

The course is held in the state-of-the-art academic facility in Alder Hey Children's Hospital, Liverpool, a vibrant cultural metropolis boasting a rich history, the Liverpool Football Club and of course, The Beatles. The venue is only a short distance from the city centre and the central railway station, and 7.5 miles from the international airport. There are good hotels near the venue for overnight accommodation.
