This privacy policy refers to the personal data that BAPA holds on members (you).

This is stored with secure technology to protect your personal details from unauthorised access.

We do not pass on any information to any persons or bodies outside BAPA.

Various members of the executive committee hold only necessary information to enable communication with their own regional members and this is also stored securely and never passed on to unauthorised persons.
