This was a brief meeting because we held a trustee only meeting between 7.30 – 8.30pm.

- (1)The minutes of the meeting held on the 11th March were read and approved.
- (2) Matters Arising: The monthly payment to Strelix has increased to £22 per month. The grant from Councillor Harley has been received.
- (3)Lets: Otis has reported that the income from lets during March was Regular lets £1757.50; one off lets £120; party/events £208. Total £2085.50. Otis has also produced a monthly breakdown of the income from lets for the 2024 -25 financial year.
- (4)Treasurers Report : Trevor reported that the overall income for March was £3,103.34 and the expenditure was £4505.6. The deficit was mainly due to the renewal of the PPL Music license (£588.83) having to acquire a TV license for the community centre and the payment of business rates (£172.65). Barbara reported that donations had been received from the Repair Café (£200), the Community Lunch (£120) and the Creative Writing Group (£40).
- (5) Correspondence: Modern Art Oxford request to support a grant application for a City Council grant. This was agreed. Oxford City and Oxford University Morris Dancers information about their availability to perform at community centres and community events. Warnford Hospital information about events to celebrate

the hospitals 200th anniversary – see notice on notice board. City Council – information about a review meeting with Officers and Councillors – the date for the review has still to be arranged.
