

SPEAKERS PROFILE



Zaharah Othman is a freelance writer contributing to The New Straits Times, Malaysia, where she crafts news pieces and pens her column, "Postcard from Zaharah."

Zaharah served as the Senior Producer of the Malay Service at BBC World Service for nearly 11 years in the 80's before the closure of the service in 1991.

She was also a freelance correspondent for Radio Television Malaysia and has produced documentaries, notably the award-winning "Warisan Warkah Melayu" (Legacy of the Malay Letter).

Zaharah also shares insights into the media profession and her own lifelong journey in the field. Her contributions extend to education, where she serves as a Malay language instructor for the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office, alongside her role as a Malay Principal Examiner with Cambridge University Press & Assessment.

She is also an author of several language books published by Routledge and Harper Collins.

In the pipeline is a memoir of her life as a freelance journalist abroad.

In recognition of her contributions to the nation, particularly in disseminating international news, Zaharah received the Ahli Mangku Negara award in 2023 from the sixteenth Yang di-Pertuan Agong of Malaysia, Al-Sultan Abdullah

Haliza Hashim-Doyle is a News and Current Affairs correspondent for TV3 Malaysia, presenting and reporting from the UK and Europe.

Her professional repertoire also includes contributions to Malaysian and UK print publications; mentorship of journalism students; giving media talks and workshops; as well as production of short TV documentaries.

In 2023, she was awarded the Ahli Mangku Negara medal by the Malaysian King for her service to the country



CHARITY RAFFLE



MERCY Humanitarian UK, a registered charity based in London, provides medical and humanitarian aid to communities in crisis.

During the pandemic, MERCY delivered PPE to various UK healthcare centres and care homes, earning them a Golden Hearts Covid-19 special award.

In 2021, MERCY launched Talian Kasih MERCY, a mental health helpline for Malaysian students in the UK, which was later expanded to include services in France and Germany.

In March, MERCY also sent a team of ten medical professionals, including surgeons, anaesthetists, and nurses, to Nepal to conduct cleft lip and palate surgery on underpriviliged children.
