If you are a teacher based within in the M25, you are eligible to be a member of the London Suzuki Group.

This is at no extra cost to you and will give you and your students access to more events and opportunities, as well as a means-tested bursary programme and assistance for those with special educational needs and disabilities.

To qualify for LSG teacher membership, the families in your studio need to be members of the LSG; LSG membership is in place of BSMA membership and part of the LSG membership fee goes to the BSMA directly. Currently family membership of the LSG is £96 per annum, which can be paid in 3 instalments by direct debit or in one payment annually.

The number of families your studio needs to have to be a member of the LSG is determined by your level:

Teacher Level 0 (beginning training) to level 1: year 1 of membership, no members needed (eg, you can sign up as an LSG Teacher before you have any LSG families). Year 2, at least 1 family. By year 3, you need at least 3 LSG member families.

Levels 2-5, year 1, you can sign up without any LSG members. By the 2nd year of your LSG teacher status, 3 LSG member families are needed. If this drops down, you have one year to increase it back to 3 before you would revert to BSMA membership only.

As an LSG teacher, you are part of the community of around 60 London-based teachers, with regular email newsletters to you during term time detailing events and opportunities, as well as the change to promote your Suzuki events. You also will be listed on the LSG website as a teacher, to help families find you easier. It is expected the LSG website will be updated in the coming year.
