

British Suzuki Music Association Code of Conduct

Date of last review: October 2025

All staff, teachers and volunteers working with children in relation to an event organised by the BSMA are required:

- to read and be aware of the BSMA Child Protection Policy
- to value, help, listen to and respect children
- to share any concerns they may have concerning the treatment of any child by an BSMA teacher or by staff, teachers and volunteers working with children in relation to an event organised by the BSMA with the BSMA and with appropriate agencies
- to be sensitive concerning situations such as where an individual is left alone with a child, and ensure that where they arise this is with appropriate parental consent.

The BSMA is not responsible for and does not control conduct at events organised by teachers who are members of the BSMA that are not BSMA events, but it encourages its teachers to apply the same rules to such events.
