The Summer Project aims to bring 60 young people together to create a fantastic show. OFFICIAL OVERVIEW

Be careful what you wish for, as Stephen Sondheim's and James Lapine's cockeyed fairytale comes to life in this adaptation of their groundbreaking, Tony Award-winning musical. *Into the Woods JR*. features all of your favourite characters — Cinderella, Little Red Riding Hood, Jack (and his beanstalk) and the Witch — in this lyrically rich retelling of classic Brothers Grimm fables.

The musical centres on a baker and his wife, who wish to have a child; Cinderella, who wishes to attend the King's festival; and Jack, who wishes his cow would give milk. When the baker and his wife learn that they cannot have a child because of a witch's curse, the two set off on a journey to break the curse, and wind up changed forever.

All applicants should arrive promptly to register and sign in. Anyone wishing to audition after the registration time will not be admitted. The audition form available from our website must be completed. Please also bring this along to your audition with a passport sized photo of the applicant attached to it.

Recall Audition

Following your first audition, you will be notified if you are required to attend the recall audition.

CLOTHING

Applicants are required to wear sensible clothing and footwear (no heels) for auditions. Soft soled shoes are essential as you will not be allowed to audition either barefoot or in socks. All applicants will take part in a physical warm up so please come in comfortable, loose clothing.

Please do not wear jewellery or anything that might prohibit your movement or cause an injury to you or others.

HOW THE AUDITION DAY WORKS

Once all the applicants are signed in, the members of the creative team will introduce themselves and explain how the workshop will be run.

Applicants do not need to prepare anything for the audition workshop which is 90 minutes. They will be taught a verse and chorus from the show and a short dance piece on the day. It's important to highlight that we don't expect only the 'best' singers, dancers, and actors; we like to recognise potential and work with individuals throughout the process.

It's important to highlight you are auditioning to be part of the company this year not for the a particular character.

The creative team will select which applicants are required to attend the recall auditions on Sunday 19 May, so it is vital that you are available on that day as well. However, not everyone who is cast will be recalled, so don't worry if you aren't recalled.

CTC will not take any responsibility for personal belongings that may get lost in the building.

Parents/guardians are not permitted to watch the audition workshop but are allowed to stay in the foyer area, please note is does get busy as there are other activities taking place in building.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

PARTICIPATION FEE

£250 per participant.

If a family has more than one sibling participating in the project, each additional sibling will be charged £200.

The participation fee does not include meals or transportation, which remain the responsibility of parents/guardians. CTC endeavour to keep project participation fees as low as possible but, unfortunately, we do have to cover the rise in costs for venue hire, pastoral care and tuition fees during the project period.

The participation fee is per project and will be eligible for the Gift Aid scheme as we are a registered charity. This means that for every £1 paid to us, we will be able to secure 25p to support Cambridge Theatre Company. If you participate in the project we will forward you a Gift Aid declaration, which we very much hope you will complete.

BURSARY FUND

There are a limited number of bursary places on offer for those who genuinely cannot afford the fees. Please contact Louis Ling, **louis@ camtheatrecompany.co.uk** for a subsidised place application form. You may be asked to supply proof of household earnings.

FEE PAYMENT SCHEDULE

There are two payment schedule options:

Option 1 - Full payment of the participation fee to be made in mid-May 2024 on the applicant accepting a part in *Into the Woods*.

Option 2 - £150 to be paid in mid-May 2024 on the applicant accepting a part in *Into the Woods*. The remaining balance of £100 to be paid by Friday 5 July 2024.

CTC will provide costumes; participants will be asked to provide some basic elements of their costume that hopefully can be found easily at home or from a charity shop etc.

BREAKDOWN OF CHARACTERS

Please note that all roles are available, and casting is open. Newcomers to Cambridge Theatre Company are welcome and encouraged and are committed to ensuring the diversity within the community in the story, with regards to the race and ethnicity of the characters as described below, is represented with our casting.

We encourage applications for this project especially from performers who identify as Black, Asian or Mixed Race.

MALES

NARRATOR/MYSTERIOUS MAN:

Sophisticated storyteller. Must have excellent timing and good sense of humour.

JACK:

The feckless giant killer who is 'almost a man.' He is adventurous, naive, energetic, and bright-eyed.

THE BAKER:

A harried and insecure baker who is simple and loving, yet protective of his family. He wants his wife to be happy and is willing to do anything to ensure her happiness but refuses to let others fight his battles.

WOLF:

Hungry and insatiable hunter who takes advantage of the weak by misleading and captivating his prey.

PRINCE:

Vain and gorgeous, he is disloyal and shallow, always searching for the next new, exciting thing.

RAPUNZEL'S PRINCE:

Shallow, competitive with his brother, the other prince.

MILKY WHITE:

Milky White does not speak or sing-must be very expressive with excellent physicality and good dancer.

FEMALE

CINDERELLA:

A young, earnest maiden who is constantly mistreated by her stepmother and stepsisters.

JACK'S MOTHER:

Browbeating and weary, Jack's protective mother who is independent, bold, and strong-willed.

THE BAKER'S WIFE:

Determined and bright woman who wishes to be a mother. She leads a simple yet satisfying life and is very low maintenance yet proactive in her endeavours. Great comic timing.

CINDERELLA'S STEPMOTHER:

The mean-spirited, demanding stepmother of Cinderella.

FLORINDA AND LUCINDA:

Cinderella's stepsisters who are black of heart. They follow in their mother's footsteps of abusing Cinderella. Big personalities.

LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD:

A spoiled young girl who is strong-willed, quick-witted, fearless, yet youthful and naive.

THE WITCH:

Sarcastic, ugly then-gorgeous, obsessive protector of Rapunzel. Blunt, straightforward and aggressive. Big personality, great comic timing.

RAPUNZEL:

Tormented young woman, daughter of the Witch.

CINDERELLA'S MOTHER:

Deceased with her soul guarding and aiding her daughter from a tree.

GRANNY:

Quick-tempered and feisty.
