CTC are looking for a cast of enthusiastic, talented, and committed young people to take part in this production of Nativity! The Musical taking place at Great Hall at The Leys.

Applicants must be at least 9 and no older than 12 years of age on Sunday 22 September. Unfortunately, we are unable to make any exceptions to these age restrictions.

Following your first audition, you will be notified if you are required to attend the recall audition.

OVERVIEW

All applicants should arrive promptly to register and sign in. Anyone wishing to audition after the registration time will not be admitted.

The audition form available from our website must be completed. Please also bring this along to your audition with a passport sized photo of the applicant attached to it.

HOW THE AUDITION WORKSHOP WORKS

Once all the applicants are signed in, the members of the creative team willintroduce themselves and explain how the workshop will be run.

Applicants do not need to prepare anything for the audition workshop which is 90 minutes. They will be taught a verse and chorus from the show and a short dance piece on the day. It's important to highlight that we don't expect only the 'best' singers, dancers, and actors; we like to recognise potential and work with individuals throughout the process.

The creative team will select which applicants are required to attend the recall auditions on Saturday 22 June, so it is vital that you are available on that day as well. However, not everyone who is cast will be recalled, so don't worry if you aren't recalled.

CTC will not take any responsibility for personal belongings that may get lost in the building.

Parents/guardians are not permitted to watch the audition workshop but are allowed to stay in the foyer area, please note is does get busy as there are other activities taking place in building.

CLOTHING

REHEARSALS & PERFORMANCES

Full commitment is expected throughout the rehearsal and production period, Regarding the regular rehearsals, if a cast member isn't required on a specific day, they will be informed in advance, but that will be a bonus! The exact breakdown of the rehearsal schedule will be made available to the cast members before the project begins.

REGULAR REHEARSAL

The first rehearsal commences on Sunday 22 September with regular rehearsals taking place as below: Tuesdays, 19:00 - 21:00 Thursdays, 19:00 - 21:00 Sundays, 11:00 - 17:00

From 5 November mid-week rehearsals will continue to 22:00

PARTICIPATION FEE

£150 per participant.

If a family has more than one sibling participating in the project, each additional sibling will be charged £100.

The participation fee does not include meals or transportation, which remain the responsibility of parents/guardians. CTC endeavour to keep project participation fees as low as possible but, unfortunately, we do have to cover the rise in costs for venue hire, pastoral care and tuition fees during the project period.

The participation fee is per project and will be eligible for the Gift Aid scheme as we are a registered charity. This means that for every £1 paid to us, we will be able to secure 25p to support Cambridge Theatre Company. If you participate in the project we will forward you a Gift Aid declaration, which we very much hope you will complete.

BURSARY FUND

There are a limited number of bursary places on offer for those who genuinely cannot afford the fees. Please contact Louis Ling, louis@camtheatrecompany.co.uk for a subsidised place application form. You may be asked to supply proof of household earnings.

COSTUMES

CTC will provide costumes; participants will be asked to provide some basic elements of their costume that hopefully can be found easily at home or from a charity shop etc.

FEE PAYMENT SCHEDULE

There are two payment schedule options:

Option 1 - Full payment of the participation fee to be made late June 2024 on the applicant accepting a part in Nativity! The Musical

Option 2 - £75 to be paid in late June 2024 on the applicant accepting a part in Nativity! The Musical. The remaining balance of £75 to be paid by end of August 2024.
