Most women prefer cotton as it is breathable so we have listed mostly cotton or cotton blends. The acrylic yarns can be used for swimming as they are not worn daily. Crochet requires a finer yarn than knit as it can be a bit stiffer so we have identified the yarns appropriate for crochet.
