"By data do you mean the Excel spreadsheet I receive at 11am every day that reminds me it's coffee time?"


"OK, OK, it's me, I give in. Now **exactly what** data do I own, what do you want me to do about it, and how much of my valuable time are you stealing?"

Data Maturity matters

- Data (and therefore Business) initiatives are highly dependent on the maturity of Data Management
- Interdependencies between the disciplines are deep and complex
- Choosing to mature only one aspect of Data
 Management at a time leads to dead ends and wasted money, time & effort



But assessments don't need to cost anything much

- Before you spend 100's of millions of Rubles or \$\frac{300}{3000}\$
 3000 Bitcoin (today's exchange rate) on a Data Maturity assessment, take a peek yourself
- You should be able to approximate a low/medium/high maturity rating fairly easily by asking the right questions
- Ask your comrades for their opinions
