



## **Five Posts Available for the Advisory Board on the Registration of Homeopathic Products**

The Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA) is looking to appoint five experts to the Advisory Board on the Registration of Homeopathic Products (ABRHP).

This is for a registered pharmacist (with an interest in homeopathy), a nurse practitioner (with an interest in homeopathy), a general practitioner/physician (with an interest in homeopathy), a general practitioner (not requiring an interest in homeopathy) and a consultant paediatrician (not requiring an interest in homeopathy).

The ABRHP advises on the safety and quality of homeopathic medicines for human use when a certificate of registration has been granted or applied for and the safety, quality and indication for use within the UK homeopathic tradition for homeopathic medicines for human use when a homeopathic marketing authorisation has been granted or applied for.

As a Member of ABRHP, you will possess or develop a working knowledge and understanding of the UK medicines regulatory procedures in relation to homeopathic medicines.

For the expert posts, the candidates should be recognised by their peers as leaders in their field and have extensive and current experience in one of the following areas as :

- a registered pharmacist (with an interest in homeopathy)
- a nurse practitioner (with an interest in homeopathy)
- a general practitioner/physician (with an interest in homeopathy)
- a general practitioner (not requiring an interest in homeopathy)
- a consultant paediatrician (not requiring an interest in homeopathy)

The successful candidates should be skilled communicators with experience of committee membership. Remuneration will be £325 per meeting for a time commitment of up to 6 meetings per year. The MHRA determines the length of appointment, which may be for up to a maximum of 4 years.
