

Levels of Health according to Classical Homeopathic Theory

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Group A Levels 1-3	Homeopathic potency up to 50M	 All diseases in Group A are mainly functional disturbances The diseases in this Group are curable by homeopathy; clear symptoms lead clearly to the correct homeopathic remedy The infrequent infections that appear are mostly of typical bacterial types Childhood diseases In the upper Levels, therapeutic homeopathic aggravations may not appear In the lower Levels, mild therapeutic homeopathic aggravations may appear In the upper Levels there is strong health, and usually no repetition of the homeopathic remedy is needed, neither is a follow-up remedy needed In the lower Levels, 2-3 homeopathic remedies in the appropriate sequence will be needed In the lower Levels, acute diseases appear more frequently
Group B Levels 4-6	Homeopathic potency 200C – 10M	 As we go down the Levels, we see the appearance of more frequent and more severe acute conditions (e.g. pneumonia) There are bacterial infections that are more resistant to antibiotics There are more severe aggravations More homeopathic remedies, one after another, will be needed
		 In the lower Levels, acute diseases follow one another. After using strong chemical medicines, the level of health descends and chronic conditions appear In the lower Levels, therapeutic homeopathic aggravations can last a long time
Group C Levels 7-9	Homeopathic potency 30C – 200C	 We see the appearance of chronic degenerative diseases (e.g. Crohn's disease, ulcerative colitis) in this Group In the upper Levels, there are fewer acute diseases which are also quite mild in their occurrence, and these mild acute diseases dissipate easily In the lower Levels, no acute conditions appear
		 In the upper Levels, there are very severe initial therapeutic homeopathic aggravations In the upper Levels, homeopathic therapeutic aggravations can be dangerous, and chemical intervention may be necessary Generally, 4-5 homeopathic remedies, in the appropriate order, will be needed.
		 In the lower Levels, an aggravation without amelioration may mean that the remedy was wrong



Group D Levels 10- 12	Homeopathic potency 6C - 30C repeated	 This Group has the severest chronic diseases with deep pathology We see no acute infections at all in this Group There are only superficial ameliorations with change of symptoms and frequent change of remedy. If a homeopathic aggravation appears, then the remedy was possibly wrong In the lowest Levels, cases are incurable, and only palliation is possible
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
