**Initial situation:** Potsdamer Platz represents Berlin's transformation like no other place - from a former entertainment district to the border strip of the Berlin Wall to a modern business quarter. With the development after 1990, Tilla Durieux Park was created here as a defining open space project. As a land art sculpture, it provided a striking impulse in the context of commercial architecture. Today, the green space is heavily used and visibly affected by erosion and rising temperatures.

**Task:** We are looking for concepts that build on the creative impulse of the time when Tilla Durieux Park was created and further develop the urban space in a climate-adapted and versatile manner. How can this central open space develop new qualities?

Public Spaces  
in Transition –  
Visions for the  
West of Freiburg

**Initial situation:** The city of Freiburg is considered a pioneer in sustainable urban development. However, even here, pressure on land, housing and nature is growing. In the west of the city, established neighbourhoods meet new development areas. The course of the Dreisam river with its striking 'gas sphere' – a listed gas storage facility – forms a central landscape axis, which is, however, fragmented by transport routes and barriers.

**Task:** A model is sought for a coherent landscape that combines ecological functions with recreational uses and urban relevance. How can nature, climate resilience and quality of life be strengthened and the gasometer integrated as a place that creates identity?
