

New Collaboration with Six Degrees Social Enterprise

We are collaborating with Six Degrees Social Enterprise to deliver a 3-year Cultural Consultancy Project as part of Greater Manchester Bereavement Service (GMBS).

The aim of the Project is to improve accessibility of the Global Majority communities to GMBS. We have recruited and trained twelve people from the Chinese and Arabic Speaking communities to work as Cultural Consultants. They attended seven training sessions from June to July 2024.

The benefits to the Cultural Consultants will be:-

- Received accredited training (AQA) on working across cultures, counselling skills and how health care systems work
- Raise awareness of issues affecting communities
- Support professionals to understand your culture and community
- Voluntary and paid position
- Able to offer information, advice and raise awareness
- Able to understand the barriers to services for people from different cultures
- Able to talk about complex or distressing information sensitively

FRAPP Update

The Family Reunion and Parenting Project was launched in February 2021 as a four-year project, and is delivered in collaboration with Rainbow Haven. The main aim to enable migrating families to overcome the impact of separation and manage challenges of parenting in a new country across cultures.

From February 2023 to July 2024 the team has:-

- -**Delivered 5 parenting courses** to 19 parents from a range of communities: Bangladesh, Pakistan, Sudan, Palestine, India, Cameroon, Ethiopia, Eritrea, Libya, Egypt.
- **-Delivered 8 Family Reunion groups to 43 parents and 47 children** from: Sudan, Eritrea, Syria, Yemen, Libya, Iran, Somalia, Ethiopia, Namibia and Cameroon. This one-day creative group, helps families focus on creating a sense of community, using the Tree of Life, retelling of stories and concludes with a celebration.
- -Provided support, through "Peer Mentoring", to 9 families transitioning out of the project, by linking up with appropriate services to help with ongoing issues, such as housing.
- -Additionally, supplied **7 single session "Parenting Workshops" to 39 parents** offering further understanding and providing support to those who cannot access other groups due to the instability of their situation.
