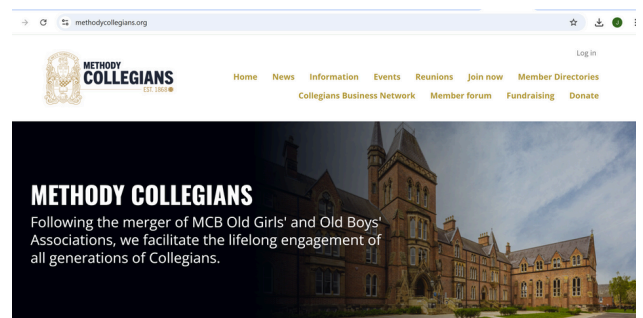
WELCOME


START CONNECTING NOW
