Since achieving the acknowledgement, a number of things have snow-balled. Firstly I was invited to share my findings at the Cutting Edge Research event hosted by CDI/NICEC. Through this, I have made some new connections and have joined new communities. This has then led to new business opportunities. This has then led to meeting new people and further business opportunities. All of this, has in itself further increased profile within the field.
