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- The Challenge of Change (UDACE, 1986)- Defined Educational Guidance
 - Personal, vocational and educational common factor 'We are making a choice, and in seeking a means to make that choice as wisely as possible' (1986: 18)
- Career guidance in 37 countries: Contrast and common themes (Watts and Sultana, 2004)
 - Career guidance defined as 'referring to services intended to assist individuals of any age and at point throughout their lives, to make educational, training and occupational choices and to manage their careers' (2004: 107)
