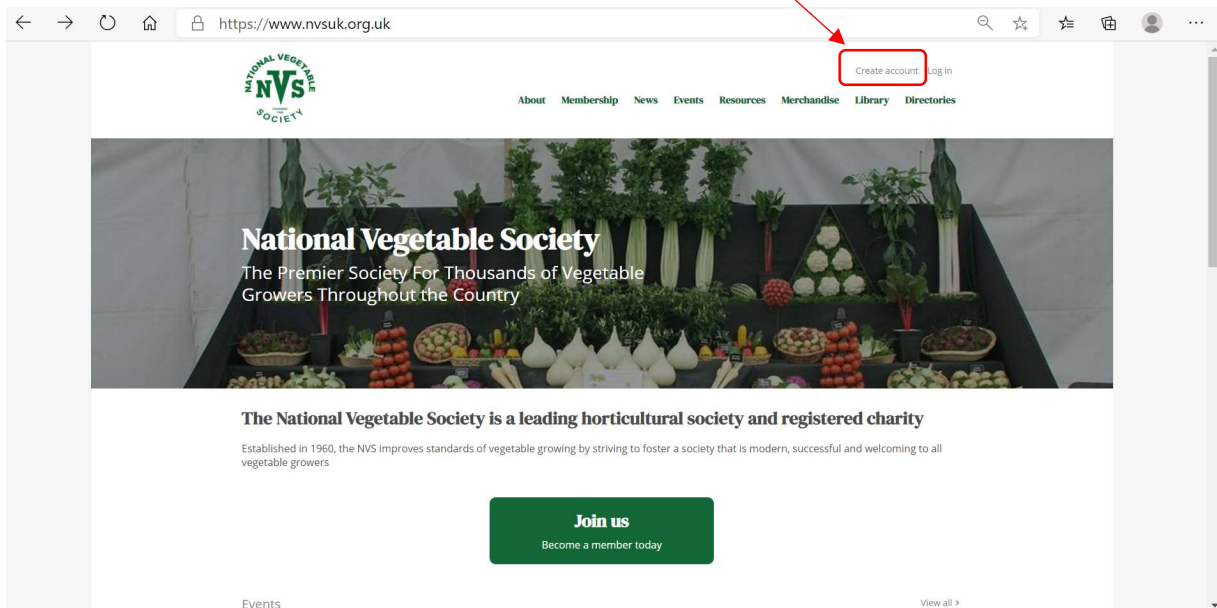




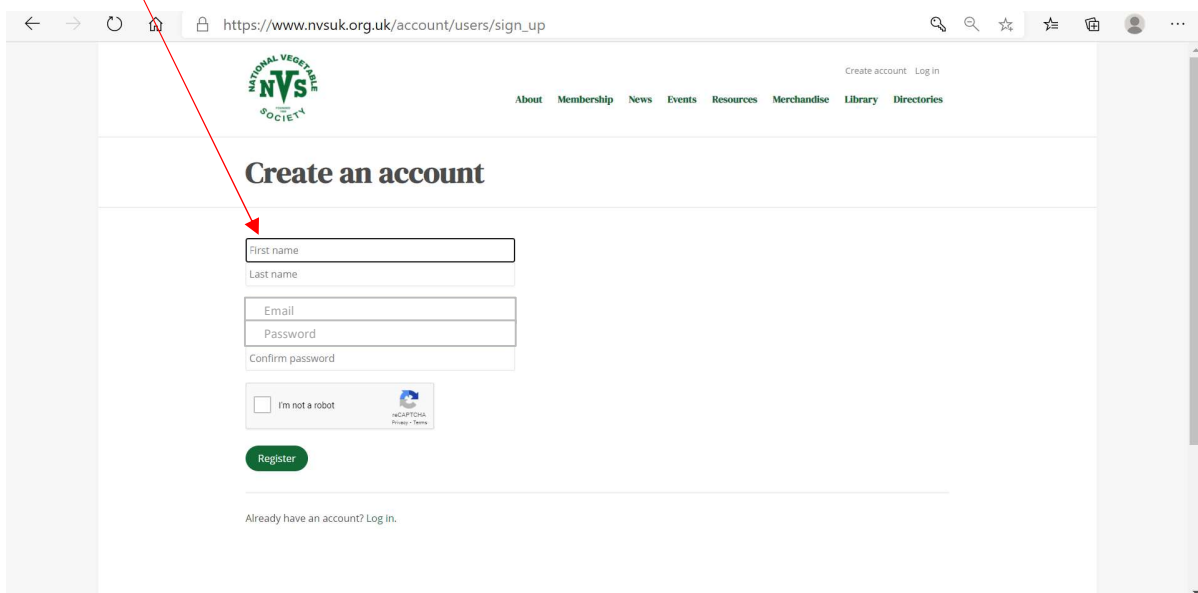
How to Create your user Account to enable you to log in as an NVS member

when you see the NVS web page, click on "Create Account"



The following "Create an account" Screen will appear

click on the first box that says First name and type in your First Name



Continue to click on the next box and fill in your Surname

Click on the box marked Email and type in your email address. (ideally this should match the one we may already have in the system for you)

Think of a password and type it in the first password box, then type it again in the "Confirm password" box. (The example below was made up for a Mr Joe Bloggs)

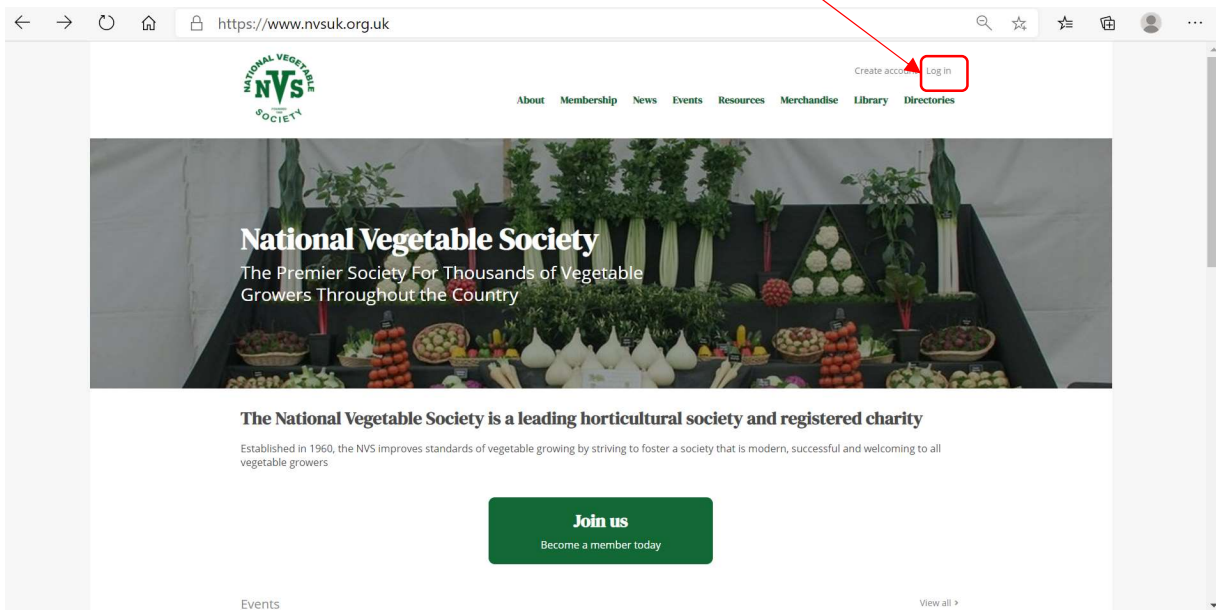
Select all images with parking meters

Verify

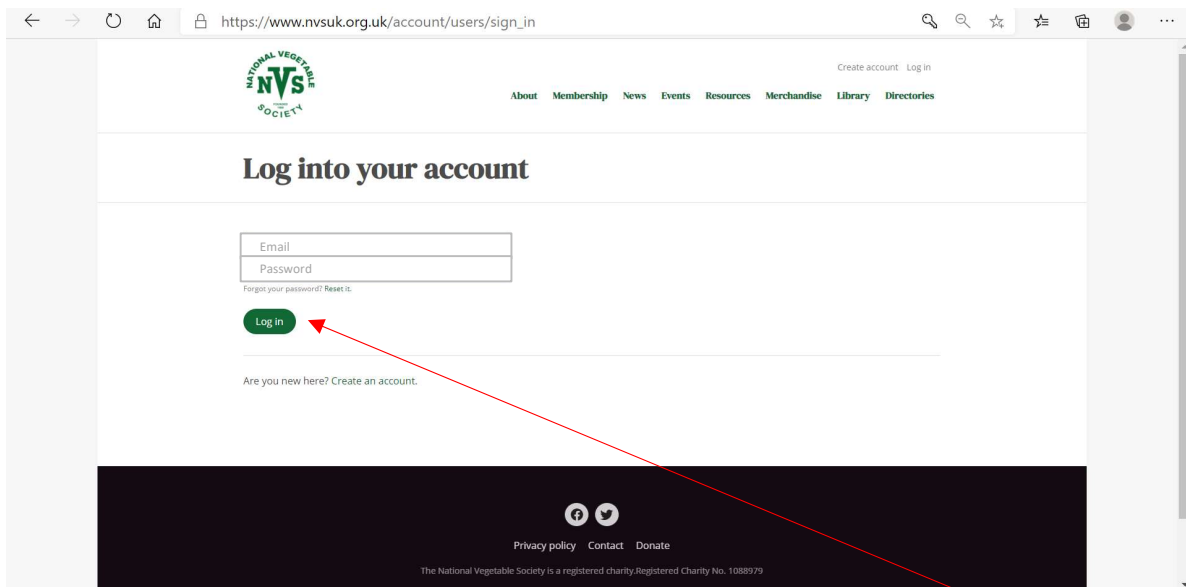
After this has been verified, click on **Register**

The following "Log into your account" Screen will appear, as shown below

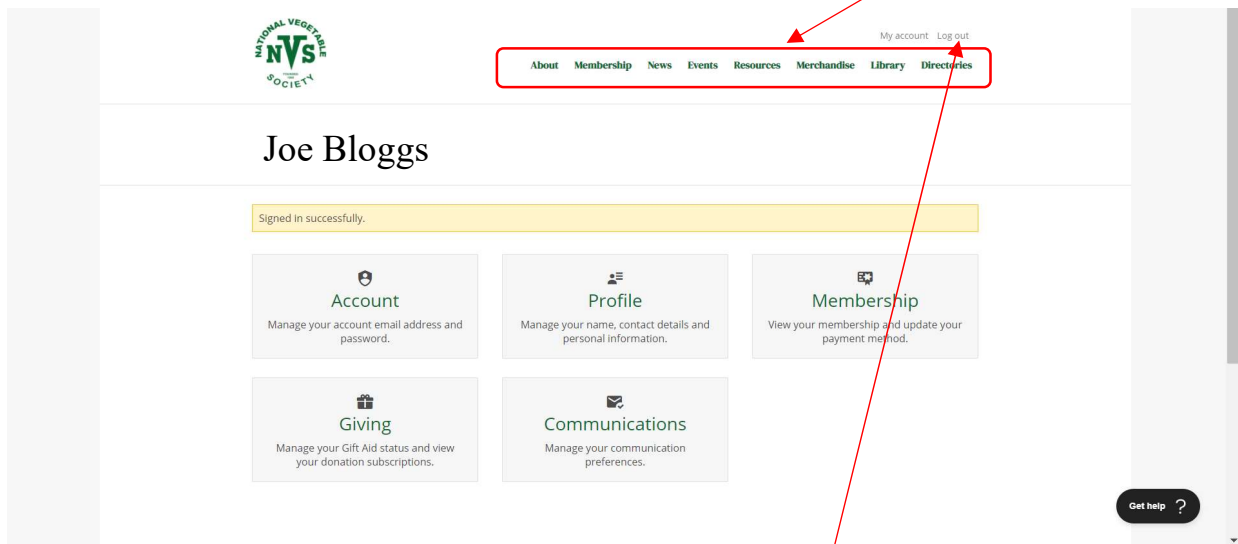


Just type in your email address and password in the boxes provided, then click on



Once signed in , your own account screen will appear similar to the example below
To access any of your account , profile etc, just click on any of the large grey boxes.

If you just want to now use the web site, then , you can click on any of the green headers

The screen will display that you have signed out successfully (and will have changed back to "Log in")
