### Classes

- 1) Collection of 4 kinds of Vegetables, 3 of each kind, except Peas, Beans & Cherry Tomatoes which must be 6. (The Cockney Cup)
- 2) 3 Blanch or Intermediate Leeks
- 3) "Five Kinds of Vegetables". One specimen of each to be staged within a frame measuring 15in x 15in, frame supplied. Each item to receive a maximum of 10 points.
- 4) 3 Carrots, Long Pointed, 3-inch tops
- 5) 3 Parsnips
- 6) 4 Potatoes, White
- 7) 4 Potatoes, Coloured
- 8) 3 Beetroot Globe. (D.A. Shield)
- 9) 3 Carrots, Stump Rooted, 3-inch tops. (The Alf Ashby Trophy)
- 10) 10 Exhibition Shallots. (The Brian Crust Trophy)
- 11) 5 Onions, 250g or Under
- 12) 5 Onions, Large Exhibition. (The Alan Mackey Challenge Shield)
- 13) 5 Medium Tomatoes, indoor grown and in good condition
- 14) 9 Cherry Tomatoes, (Round)
- 15) 2 Cucumbers, indoor grown
- 16) 6 Runner Beans
- 17) 1 Heavy Onion. To be judged by weight. No more than 3-inch neck, single necked and in good condition. Untied. (To be staged on ring supplied)
- 18) 6 French Beans. (NVS Plaque & Card)

**The Cockney Tray will be awarded to the best single dish in Classes 2 to 16.**

**The Bert Park Trophy will be awarded for most points in Classes 2 to 16.**

**The Geoff Prior FNVS Perpetual Bowl will be awarded to the best dish of Tomatoes in Classes 13 and 14.**

- 1) Entries must be returned to the Show Secretary by Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September 2023.  
**NO LATE EXHIBITS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE**
- 2) There are no entry fees to any of the classes.
- 3) The competition is open to all paid up members of the NVS and one member of a society affiliated to the NVS. Affiliated society members must have their entry form signed by the affiliated society Chairman before their entry is accepted by the Show Secretary.
- 4) Staging of exhibits from 6pm until 9pm Friday 8<sup>th</sup> September 2023 & 8:30am until 10:45 am on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2023.
- 5) Show to be judged by National Vegetable Society Rules.
- 6) No exhibit to be removed before 4pm on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2023.
- 7) Plates, Dishes, Sand and Frames are supplied by the D.A. for Classes 2 to 18 and **MUST** be used where appropriate.
- 8) Onions and Shallots to be tied with natural raffia only.
- 9) Protests of right to appeal by exhibitors. All protests must be logged in writing with the Show Secretary within one hour of the Show opening. A sum of £5 must also accompany any protest. In any event of any dispute the Show Secretary's decision is final!
