- All horticulture entries must be grown by the exhibitor with the exception of the U18 class 'Mr Potato Head Creation'.
- 2. Judge's decision is final.

NOTE- Fruit and Vegetables, Farm Produce and U18 classes only: Limited staging on Saturday morning strictly before 7.30am however vehicular access to the marquee will not be permitted and exhibitors will therefore have to walk with exhibits from the main car parks.

- 4. Presentation will be considered by the judge.

Description: To be displayed flat on the table with approx. 75mm of stalk.

Description: 3 sticks to be displayed flat on the table. Leaf blades to be trimmed

back to approximately 75mm.

Description: RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1. This competition is to encourage growers to exhibit produce from their own kitchen garden.
- In this competition the produce should be the property of and be grown by the exhibitor.
- Each exhibit must consist of a display of fruit and vegetables excluding potatoes.
- 4. Not fewer than 7 kinds.
- 5. Not more than 10. Foliage and root growth may be trimmed for display purposes and herbs may be included.
- 6. The veg and fruit should be displayed within area not larger than 610mm x 610mm (24"x24") and height not exceeding 90cm (3ft).
- 7. However, foliage and roots may extend beyond that boundary but not rest on the show bench.
- 8. [FINAL Tullamore: Marquee open from 7.30am on show morning and will be closed for judging at 10am sharp. Marquee will open to the public at 12 noon.]
- 9. [FINAL Tullamore: Exhibits cannot be removed before 5.00pm.

• Condition and quality: 50 points

 The variety to be correctly named. Each tuber should be free from skin
 blemishes, be true to type, and weigh approximately 6 ozs. (170g).
- 3. Two exhibits to qualify at each show.
- 4. This being a quality championship, the adjudicators will favour floury, high dry matter varieties, which are popular with the Irish customer.
- 5. These rules should be read in conjunction with the Irish Shows Association Rules.
- 6. [FINAL Tullamore: Marquee open from 7.30am on show morning and will be closed for judging at 10 am sharp. Marquee will open to the public at 12 noon.]
- 7. [FINAL Tullamore: Exhibits cannot be removed before 5.00pm.]

- In this competition, the produce must be the property of and grown by the exhibitor.
- 2. Each exhibit is to consist of the following: A dish of 5 onions of any variety.
- 3. The onions may be grown from either seed or sets.
- 4. The onions may be Autumn or Spring sown. The variety to be correctly named.
- 5. Each onion must be tied and weigh not more than 450grams.
- 6. The onions to be harvested and have clear unbroken skins.
- 7. A special qualifying class will be held at selected shows. Two exhibits may qualify for the Final, if the Judges agree that the standard is high enough.

COMPETITION WILL BE JUDGED AS FOLLOWS:

Condition/ Quality: 25 pointsUniformity and Shape: 25 points

Size/ Weight: 10 points, Colour: 10 pointsOverall presentation/ attractiveness: 10 points

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Judge's decision will be final at all stages of the competition. Exhibits are displayed at owner's risk. These rules should be read in conjunction with the I.S.A. Rules.
