RULES

The competition is open to all NVS members and to eligible members of societies or other bodies affiliated to The National Vegetable Society. Free class entry.

Entry is restricted to one entry per member per class, and must be the property of, and have been grown by, the exhibitor.

Staging and judging: Staging of exhibits will begin on Friday evening from 4pm to 10.00pm and again on Saturday morning from 7.00am till 9.00am. Judging will start at 9.00am with the aim of completing judging by 12.00 noon.

Dishes will be supplied for Potato classes.

Peas, Tomatoes, Shallots, Onion Sets and 250gm Onions to be displayed on boards provided.

Onions and Shallots to be tied with natural raffia.

All tap root vegetable tops to be trimmed to approximately 76mm.

All varieties to be named using the cards provided only.

Judging will be in accordance with the rules as laid down in the 2017 NVS Judges and Exhibitors Guide and as amended 2018.

SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

NVS 1 THE JAMES SCADE MEMORIAL TROPHY for a collection of vegetables. The collection will be four kinds (number as in classes) drawn from Classes three to nineteen and will be staged in a space one metre square, boards optional.

NVS 2 MINI COLLECTION: Three kinds from: three potatoes, six peas, three carrots stump rooted, two cauliflower, two onions from sets, three tomatoes and six shallots. To be staged on flat in space $760 \, \text{mm} \times 460 \, \text{mm} = 1.5 \, \text{ft} \times 1.5 \, \text{ft}$.

NVS 3 LEEKS POT: One dish of two, to be staged on flat.

NVS 4 CAULIFLOWERS: One dish of two, to be staged on flat.

NVS 5 PEAS: One dish of nine, to be staged on board.

NVS 6 CARROTS, STUMP ROOTED: One dish of three, to be staged on flat.

NVS 7 BEETROOT, GLOBE: One dish of three, to be staged on dish.

NVS 8 TOMATOES, MEDIUM: Six, to be staged on board.

NVS 9 ONIONS, LARGE EXHIBITION: One dish of three.

NVS 10 ONIONS, FROM SETS: One dish of three, to be staged on board.

NVS 11 ONIONS: One dish of three. Each onion must not exceed 250 gms, to be staged on board.

NVS 12 SHALLOTS: Nine, pear-shaped, to be staged on board.

NVS 13 POTATOES: Five, white, one variety, to be staged on dish.

NVS 14 POTATOES: Five, coloured, one variety, to be staged on dish.

NVS 15 LEEKS BLANCH: One dish of three, to be staged on flat.

NVS 16 CELERY: One dish of two, to be staged on flat.

NVS 17 BEETROOT: Long, one dish of three, to be staged on flat.

NVS 18 PARSNIPS: One dish of three, to be staged on flat.

NVS 19 CARROTS, LONG POINTED: One dish of three, to be staged on flat.

NVS 20 THREE VEGETABLES: One of each kind. For any NVS member who has not won any red card at any NVS National or Branch Championship Show.

NVS 21 COLLECTION OF VEGETABLES: 15 points and under, four kinds, three of each, to be staged on flat in space 2ft x 1.5ft (frontage).

NVS 22 TOMATOES, SMALL FRUITED: One dish of nine, to be staged on board.

The Cockneys Goblet is awarded to the Best Exhibit, excluding classes 1 and 2.

The Provan Trophy - Winner of class 3.

The Bill Rodger Memorial Trophy – Winner of class 9.

The William Sands Memorial Trophy – Best Dish from classes 13 and 14.

The Ivor Mace Trophy – Winner of class 15.

The George Duncan Memorial Trophy – Winner of class 20.
