21)	Chilli plant in pot – pot not to exceed 20cm				
22)	A Pot Plant in Flower – Pot not to exceed 20cm				
23)	Collection of Herbs - minimum 3 cultivars - in a approx. 500g jam jar				
24)	Vase of Seasonal berries and/or seedheads – minimum 3 varieties

25)	Vase of Mixed Flowers – maximum 10 stems vase suppled				
26)	6 Fuchsia Blooms – any cultivar container supplied				

- 27) Plot to Plate using one kind of fruit or vegetable;
 2 specimens of the vegetable or fruit, except for peas, beans, cherry tomatoes, shallots and berries which must be 6
 PLUS 1 jar of chutney OR preserve to include the vegetable / fruit
 PLUS 1 baked item to include the vegetable / fruit.
- The vegetable/fruit on display must have been grown by exhibitor Each item to receive a maximum of 10 points.

The Cockney Tray will be awarded to the best single dish in Classes 2 to 18

The Bert Park Trophy will be awarded for most points in Classes 2 to 18.

The Geoff Prior FNVS Perpetual Bowl will be awarded to the best dish of Tomatoes in Classes 14 and 15.

1) Entry forms must be returned to the Show Secretary by Wednesday10th September 2025.

NO LATE EXHIBITS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE

- 2) There are no entry fees to any of the classes.
- 3) The competition is open to all paid up members of the NVS or members of a society affiliated to the NVS.
- 4) Staging of exhibits from 6pm until 9pm Friday 12th September 2025 & 8:30am until 10:45 am on Saturday 13th September 2025.
- 5) Show to be judged by National Vegetable Society Rules.
- 6) No exhibit to be removed before 4pm on Sunday 14th September 2025.
- 7) Plates, Dishes, Vases, Containers, Sand and Frames are supplied by the D.A. for some of the Classes and MUST be used where specified.
- 8) Onions and Shallots to be tied with natural raffia only.
- 9) Protests of right to appeal by exhibitors.
 All protests must be logged in writing with the Show Secretary within one hour of the Show opening.
 - A sum of £5 must also accompany any protest.

 In any event of any dispute the Show Secretary's decision is final!
- 10) Trophies to be returned on Friday 12th or Saturday 13th September 2025
