One entry per class per person.

Last entries no later than 7.55pm on the night. Visitors and accompanied junior (under 16) exhibitors welcome.

There will be a talk while judging is in progress.

Judging will be carried out under NVS rules.

Class 1	A tray of any 4 vegetables from the following: potatoes (3); stump rooted carrots (3); globe beetroot (3); mini cucumbers (2), not exceeding 200mm in length; runner beans (6); onions under 250g (3). All should fit onto a tray not exceeding 450mm x 600mm.
Class 2	Potatoes. One dish of 3 white skinned potatoes.
Class 3	Potatoes. One dish of 3 coloured potatoes.
Class 4	Carrots. One dish of 3 stump rooted carrots, tops trimmed to 75mm.
Class 5	Beetroot. One dish of 3 globe beetroot, tops trimmed to 75mm.
Class 6	Tomatoes. One dish of 3, maximum size 60mm.*
Class 7	Tomatoes. One dish of 6 small tomatoes, to pass through the 35mm.*
Class 8	Cucumbers. One dish of 2.
Class 9	French Beans. One dish of 6, with stalks.
Class 10	Runner Beans. One dish of 6, with stalks.
Class 11	Courgettes. One dish of 2.
Class 12	Onions. One dish of 3, 250g or under.
Class 13	Onions. One dish of 3, over 250g.
Class 14	One dish of vegetables not mentioned in classes 1 to 13. Refer to NVS Judges and Exhibitors Handbook (pages 4 – 7) for idea of quantities.
Class 15	A display of 4 herbs, in bunches
Class 16	Novice Class. One entry from classes 1 to 13. A novice being a person who has not won a prize at an NVS show.
Class 17	Junior Class. One dish of any kind of vegetable. A junior being somebody under the age of 16 on the day of the show.

The Banksian Medal is awarded to the competitor with the highest total prize money.

There will be a special award for the Best in Show.

Paper plates will be provided, but competitors in Class 1 (Tray of 4 Vegetables) will need to provide their own tray or use masking tape to mark out an area no larger than 450mm x 600mm.

Competitors will need to provide their own sand and/or vermiculite depending on their entries.

*** The NVS Measuring Gauge will be used, where applicable, to assess specimen size. Refer to Simply Vegetables Winter2025/26 page 36 for details.**

Vegetables can be kept fresh using water only.

The judge's decision is final.
