Class 1	Cabbage. One dish of two with a minimum of 75mm stalks.		
Class 2	Parsnips. One dish of three.		
Class 3	Leeks. Blanch or intermediate. One dish of three.		
Class 4	Carrots. Long pointed. One dish of three.		
Class 5	Carrots. Stump rooted. One dish of three.		
Class 6	Cauliflowers. One dish of two.		
Class 7	Potatoes. White. One dish of five.		
Class 8	Potatoes. Coloured. One dish of five.		
Class 9	Onions. Large exhibition. One dish of three.		
Class 10	Onions. 250g or under. One dish of five.		
Class 11	Beans. Runner. One dish of six.		
Class 12	Shallots. Exhibition. One dish of nine.		
Class 13	Cucumbers. One dish of two.		
Class 14	Tomatoes. Approximately 60mm in diameter. One dish of six.		
Class 15	Under 16's Competition. Any number of vegetables or flowers contained within a standard size seed tray, max size 39cm x 25cm.		
Classes 16 to 20 are for novices only – refer to Rule 3			
Class 16	Tomatoes. Small fruited. Not to exceed 35mm diameter. One dish of five.		
Class 17	Beans. French. One dish of five.		
Class 18	Potatoes. Coloured or white. One dish of three.		
Class 19	Courgettes. One dish of two.		
Class 20	Beetroot. Globe. One dish of three.		

Rosettes and prize cards will be awarded:

- To exhibits achieving 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in Classes 1 to 14.
- To exhibits achieving 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th place in Classes 15 to 20.
- To the exhibitor gaining the most points.
- To the most meritorious exhibit.

PHOTOGRAPHIC NOTES:

- All photographs submitted must be in high resolution colour and saved as a JPEG file.
- Photographs must be in focus to allow judges to assess exhibits. If photographs
 are deemed inadequate for fair assessment of entries then exhibits will be
 discounted by the judges. NIF awarded (Not In Focus).
- Single photograph for each class entry, taken to give the best perspective of the exhibit. Consider taking an angled shot of to show the top and front of each exhibit.
- 4) All photographs to have a one pound coin included for scale.

Show Rules

- The National Vegetable Society Southern Branch Fun Virtual Show is free to enter for all current members of the NVS and all current members of an NVS Affiliated Society.
- 2. Each exhibitor can only enter one exhibit per class, which must be the property of and be grown by the Exhibitor.
- 3. Classes 16 to 20 are classified as "novice classes" A "novice" is deemed to be any entrant who has NOT won a place card at any NVS National Championship or at any NVS Branch Championship.
- 4. All Entry Forms must be emailed to <u>chair.nvs-sb@outlook.com</u> no later than 11.59pm on Sunday, 17th July 2022. Postal entries are acceptable however no telephone entries will be accepted. Late entries will be considered for acceptance at the Show Organisers discretion. A confirmation of entry will be sent to each exhibitor for emailed entries only.

- 5. Judges officiating at the Southern Branch Championship Virtual Show are permitted to enter exhibits into any Class at those Shows.
- 6. The Show Organisers reserves the right to refuse entry to any exhibitor, as per NVS rules. In the event of such a refusal, an explanation will be given.
- Judging will be in accordance with the rules as laid down in the 2017 NVS Judges and Exhibitors Guide and as amended 2018.
- 8. Photographs of exhibits may be taken any time between 25th July 2022 and 4th September 2022 inclusive.
- 9. All photographic entries must be emailed to <u>chair.nvs-sb@outlook.com</u> and be received no later than 11.59pm on Monday, 5th September 2022.
- Any photograph suspected of being doctored, i.e. Photoshopped or being airbrushed will disqualify the entrant from taking part in the Competition.
- 11. All top foliage on root vegetables to be trimmed to approximately 75mm and all cabbages to be shown with approximately 75mm stalk and cauliflowers with approximately 75mm stalk.
- 12. Any material may be used for the tying of onions and shallots. Shallots may be grown from either sets or seed.
- The use of any foreign substance on the exhibit is strictly forbidden as described in the 2017 NVS Judges and Exhibitors Guide and as amended 2018.
- 14. Judging will be carried out on 7th and 8th September 2022 with the results expected to be published by 12th September. This will be subject to change depending on entry numbers.
- 15. The Judge's decision is final.
