1. Onions Three, large exhibition.
2. Onions Three, each to be 250 grams or under
3. Tomatoes Five medium
4. Tomatoes Five cherry
5. Potatoes Five, white
6. Potatoes Five, coloured
7. Carrots Three, stump rooted
8. Shallots Six, large exhibition
9. Sweet Peppers Three
10. Runner Beans Six
11. Any Other Veg not listed above, 1 Variety, numbers as shown in the NVS/RHS Handbook. (Please ask if you require advice)
12. Salad Class. A collection of salads displayed in a basket/trug (Max size 18") at least 3 from the following: tomatoes, lettuce, spring onions, radishes, cucumber, sweet peppers, fennel, beetroot, celery.
13. A vase of culinary herbs, 3 kinds, named.
14. A dish of fruit, half the number shown in the RHS Show handbook rounded up.
15. 5 stems of annual flower, one kind
16. 5 stems of perennial flower, one kind
