No exhibit can be removed until 3.45pm. Any exhibit remaining after 4.00pm will be deemed to be the property of the organisers and will be auctioned;

Entries will be accepted between 6.00pm and 9.00pm on the Friday before the Show and between 7.00am and 10.00am on the day of the Show;

All exhibits must be staged by 10.15am and judging will commence at 10.30am;

Entry fee for all classes is 25p per exhibit, except Children's Class and Allotment Class which are free of charge. Children entering any other class will still be charged the standard entry fee.
