



Greener PCPA Award 2025: Judging Criteria

Submissions are invited from an individual or team for an initiative or project demonstrating positive outcomes for patient care and/or staff wellbeing, and reduction in waste, carbon footprint or broader environmental impact. The impact will be measurable with evidence to show changes have been embedded in future practice.

Alignment with Principles of Sustainable Healthcare

- Prevention How does the project help to reduce the need for future treatment or prevent illness?
- Patient Empowerment In what ways does the initiative support patients in managing their own health and making informed, sustainable choices?
- **Lean Systems** How does the approach reduce duplication, inefficiencies, or unnecessary interventions?
- Low Carbon Alternatives Have they implemented or promoted alternatives that reduce carbon emissions (e.g., switching inhalers, transport methods, or prescribing practices)?
- Sustainable Resource Use How are they ensuring optimal use of materials, medicines, or energy within your practice or service?
