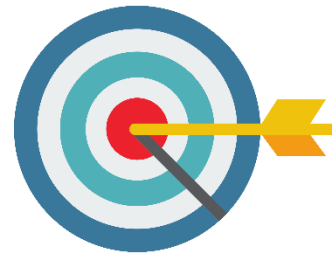


London Campaign Network

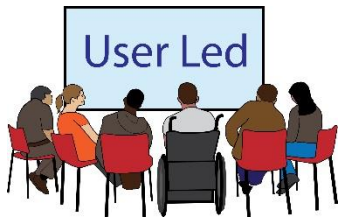


The 4 big aims:

1. We want to set up a 'London Campaign Network' of self-advocates with learning difficulties/disabilities.
2. We will find opportunities to work together on campaigns that matter to us all.
3. We want to influence the people that make decisions about us.
4. We want to improve the lives of people with learning difficulties/disabilities across London.



Many self advocacy groups have closed or have been taken over and our member groups have dropped by 50% in the last 10 years.



We want to work with existing self advocacy organisations across London and support groups to set up in areas where they don't exist.

We expect:



- People with learning difficulties/disabilities to have a louder voice and a bigger profile
- Self-advocacy organisations to work together and influence policy
- Self-advocacy organisations to be able to manage themselves better
- Groups who are under threat of closure or changes that they don't agree with to have support
