WHO WE ARE

Providence Row is a homelessness charity and we have helped people in East London in times of crisis since 1860. We provide a safe space, food, warmth and access to advice and support

so that our clients can develop their skills and confidence and create healthy, independent lives away from the streets.





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In 2023/2024 the demand for our services and support has continued to grow. We saw homelessness figures in London increase sharply fuelled by a lack of affordable housing and the ongoing cost of living crisis. We are grateful that thanks to the incredible dedication of our donors, staff and volunteers we managed to support people affected by homelessness in East London and helped them build a better future during these difficult times. We are excited to have been able to develop our Health Hub in the last year to bring even more access to healthcare services onsite to our clients. We also started the redevelopment of our Resource Centre to make sure we can provide them with even better tailored support in the years to come."





We provided

4,167

nutritious meals to people affected by homelessness in our kitchen.





We helped

rough-sleepers in Tower Hamlets, the City of London and Hackney, who struggled with mental health access our outreach psychotherapy support.



Our Routes to Roots project supported

individuals in Tower Hamlets and Hackney at risk of being discharged from hospitals onto the streets, ensuring access to safe and stable accommodations.

We supported

individuals to access washing facilities, phone charging, a postal address, IT facilities and to engage with many other services from our Food Programme, to Progression and Training to our Advice and Support Service.



We helped

clients with their substance and alcohol issues through harm reduction advice and referral into Reset treatment and recovery services. Our Needle Exchange and Harm Reduction service helped 181 individuals.



We helped

individuals create CVs and 11 participants secured employment. We ran

Health & Wellness Fairs at Providence Row's Day Centre where

individuals were able to access health checks and advice.

We distributed

Naloxone kits to service users and support agencies. Naloxone is a vital lifesaving drug that can reverse the effects of an opiate overdose.





In total we supported almost

people affected by homeless in East London.





When a client walks into our Day Centre we want to be able to provide them with a variety of support. We also bring support to rough sleepers on the streets and work with other organisations to bring our support within the community. The help we provide includes:



Access to **outreach psychotherapy support** for those who struggle with their mental health



Employability support: help with CVs and job hunting. We also run free IT, catering and gardening courses on site



Our Day Centre: it provides a warm, safe space where people can get a hot drink, breakfast, lunch, a shower, access to the internet and phone charging. This is also an opportunity for people to discuss the longer term help they need



Advice on: housing, benefits and how to register with a GP



Our award-winning quarterly Health and Wellness Fairs where people can access health checks and advice



A harm reduction service: we support people with drug and alcohol dependency with a needle exchange as well as advice and support to overcome substance use disorders. We work in a non-judgemental and non-coercive way to help people improve their quality of life.
