Role purpose

- To deliver a safe and effective onsite catering service
- To coordinate trainees, volunteers and corporate groups to deliver kitchen support

Key responsibilities

- Prepare, cook and serve meals to agreed menus, quality standards and service times.
- Follow Providence Row's food safety procedures, including Safer Food Better Business and HACCP controls, ensuring that food preparation, storage, allergens, cleaning, waste disposal and kitchen records meet required standards.
- Organise daily food preparation and allocate appropriate tasks to trainees, volunteers and other kitchen participants when in attendance.
- Check deliveries, stock levels, storage temperatures, stock rotation and use-by dates, informing the Catering Manager promptly of shortages or ordering requirements.
- Ensure kitchen equipment is used safely and report faults, maintenance needs or other operational concerns promptly.
- Support effective portion control, minimise food waste and maximise recycling wherever possible.
- Open and/or close the kitchen when authorised and oversee day-to-day kitchen operations in the Catering Manager's absence, within agreed delegated authority.
- Provide practical kitchen instruction and day-to-day supervision to catering trainees in line with the training plan agreed by the Catering Manager.
- Create a safe, supportive and professional learning environment that helps trainees develop their skills, confidence and experience.
- Provide clear, timely and constructive feedback on trainees' performance and conduct.
- Share relevant observations, achievements and concerns with the Catering Manager and designated support staff and contribute to trainee reviews and the identification of development or support needs.
