We're looking for a skilled male facilitator to join our MASC (Men Achieving Safe Change) team at MDVS on a sessional basis. This is a unique opportunity to co-deliver our respected behaviour change programme alongside an experienced female co-facilitator, working directly with men who have used abusive behaviours in their intimate relationships.

### **About the Role**

- Deliver 2 group sessions per week (evening availability may be required).
- Support men to reflect on their behaviours, take accountability, and develop safer relationship practices.
- Keep survivor and child safety at the core of all interventions, using trauma-informed, non-collusive approaches.
- Engage in reflective practice and professional supervision.

We welcome applicants from a range of backgrounds, particularly those with:

- Experience delivering groupwork or working in behaviour change, education, mental health, or criminal justice.
- Understanding of domestic abuse, coercive control, and the importance of perpetrator accountability.
- Confidence to lead on sensitive topics such as sexual respect, parenting, emotional regulation, and gender dynamics.

- Respect training or experience working to Respect standards is desirable but not essential. You will receive a full induction and ongoing support.
