The campus houses the Érasme Hospital, the Health Hub (Faculty of Medicine, Faculty of Motor Sciences, School of Public Health), the HELB School of Nursing and several museums, including the Museum of Medicine.

GETTING TO THE VENUE

The easiest way to reach Campus Érasme is by Metro (Line 5, terminus: Érasme), which runs through the centre of Brussels and stops directly at the campus entrance. More info: www.stib-mivb.be

By Train

From Bruxelles-Midi (main international station), take Metro Line 2 or 6 to “Gare de l'Ouest”, then change to Line 5 → Érasme.

From Bruxelles-Central, take Metro Line 5 directly toward Érasme.

By Air

From Brussels Airport (Zaventem), take the Airport Express train to Bruxelles-Central, then follow the Metro route above. Total journey: approx. 50 min.

From Charleroi Airport, take the official shuttle bus (Flibco) to Bruxelles-Midi, then follow the Metro route above. More info: <https://www.flibco.com>

By Car

Route de Lennik 808, accessible via the Brussels ring road (R0). Street parking is available on Allée de la Recherche, a 5-minute walk from the campus entrance. Note: Brussels has a Low Emission Zone (LEZ), check your vehicle at www.lez.brussels
