



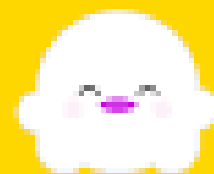

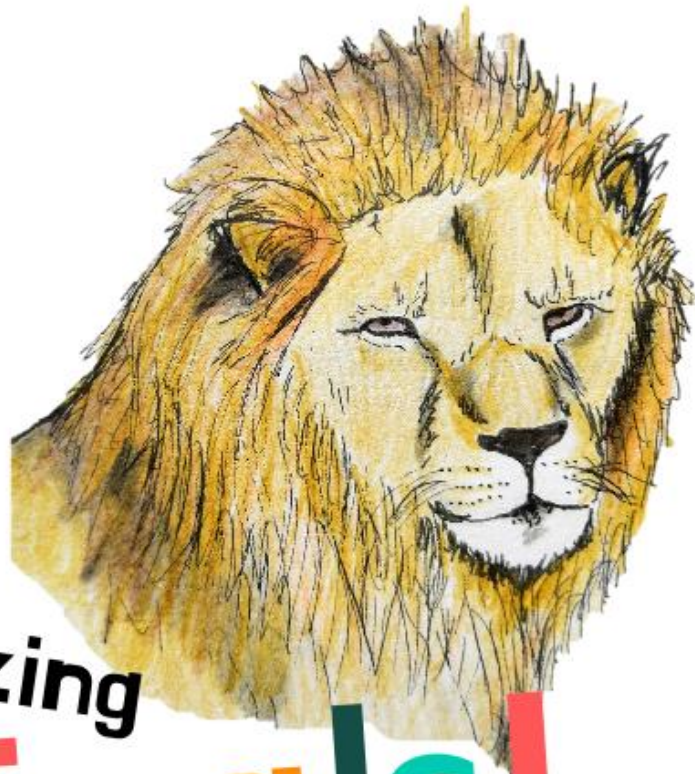


I like to sleep during the day but I'm not a bat.

True or False?

A lion's roar can be heard from as far as 5 miles away.

Male lions have the loudest roar of any big cat species. Their roar helps them find other lions as well as to proclaim their territory.

A lion may sleep up to 20 hours a day

Male lions spend 18 to 20 hours a day snoozing, while females get 15-18 hours of shuteye. The lionesses spend more time hunting and taking care of cubs.

A lion can live up to 30 years old.
