- The annual Summer Garden Party in June


 setting up, running a stand, selling raffle tickets, serving drinks and packing away are just a few of the tasks that need to be covered.

Team George is a fundraising organisation set up in memory of George Christopher Stansfield.

George was born on 30 November 2013 at Milton Keynes hospital, however unfortunately due to unforeseen complications, George's brain was deprived of oxygen during labour and was fighting for his life immediately. He was transferred to the John Radcliffe Hospital in Oxford to the intensive care neonatal unit, where the amazing staff battled to save his life. George went to sleep peacefully in the arms of his mummy and daddy on 2 December.

Throughout 2023 a series of fundraising events were held to mark the 10th anniversary of Team George. These included a golf day, family day and a charity dinner.


LONDON TO BRIGHTON BIKE RIDE
