By Train

Direct connections are provided by [LNER](#), [East Midlands Railway](#), and [Northern Rail](#), including daily services from and to Newark, Nottingham, Sheffield, Leicester, Doncaster, and London.

By car

From the North: Via the A15 (Hull) or the A46 (Grimsby)

From the South: Via the A46 (Leicester, Nottingham, Newark) or the A1 and A15 (London, East Anglia)

From the East: Via the A158 (Skegness)

From the West: Via the A1 and A57 (Leeds, Worksop, Sheffield)
